## Program Evaluation Explanations

The requirement to the left is the type of requirement where the student has a choice of ways in which to complete it.

The Liberal Arts requirement can be completed in one of three ways:

- OR 6 credits humanities and 3 credits liberal arts
- OR 6 credits social science and 3 credits liberal arts
- OR 9 credits math or science

This student has completed SOC 100, which can be used as a liberal arts in the 'Hum/Lib Arts' option and as a social science in the 'Soc Sci/Lib Arts' option. This course does not apply to the Math/Science option.
