they will receive zero points for
the repeated course.*

Bio 110, 111 or 121 in addition
to A&P I, points will only be
awarded to A&P I*

****For students retaking A&P
and/or Micro that is > 10 years
the above rule does not apply.*

**Students must have a GPA
of 2.5 or better prior to
acceptance.**

must have a GPA 2.0 or
better for admission**
