Financial Eligibility Documentation for EOP Admission

In order for us to see that you are financially eligible for EOP as a first-time college student, you must give us proof of all your sources of family income. We must have documents on file verifying the total amount of income from all sources, taxable and non-taxable, received during 2011. Students who are considered dependent for financial aid purposes need to provide income documents for themselves as well as parents. Please understand that we may request additional information after receiving your FAFSA, tax returns, and other documents listed here, if necessary to finalize your eligibility.

Eligibility for EOP does not guarantee admission to the program. EOP admissions will be closed when we reach our maximum enrollment in the program for each semester. Priority for EOP admission is given to students who:

1. show evidence of historical educational and financial disadvantage
2. demonstrate potential to be academically successful with EOP support
3. complete application and income verification earliest

A decision on EOP eligibility will not be made until verification has been completed, so please provide the required documents as soon as possible. A letter informing you of your admission or denial of admission to EOP at FLCC will be mailed after an admission decision is made.

What you should do:

1. Collect your (and your spouse’s or parents’, if applicable) financial documents (Federal income tax forms or transcripts, W2s etc.)
2. Complete all sections and **sign this application**.
3. Return the completed application with signatures **and required documents** to the EOP Office. Please note that, if the Financial Aid Office has copies of income documents, the EOP Office **does not need a second copy**, but we do need the application and any additional documents listed on this application.

Family Information
